Example A

This is a lucid and very well-structured commentary. The student has clearly identified three specific objects, all tangible ones from a specific real-world context, and has effectively linked each one to the prompt. There is a strong justification for the selection of each object through precise explanations of what they signify or illustrate and how. The points about Chinese culture within the culture and across cultures are well supported and convincing and make explicit references to the prompt. The phrasing in the commentary on the Ecuadorian doll is a bit awkward but the points are made, and criticism of the language used by students is not pertinent except where it affects communication. There is an introduction and conclusion to this exhibition, which it should be noted are **not required**. This is an excellent exhibition and deserves the top mark of 10/10.
